3 Easy Steps

to Apply for Peninsula College Scholarships:

1. Go to **www.theWashBoard.org** to create a log in and start your personal profile. *Please Note: You must use a Firefox or Chrome web browser to effectively navigate the WashBoard site.*
2. Enter Peninsula College in the “search scholarships” box in the upper right-hand corner.
3. Review the scholarship application criteria and apply!

Student Tips for Scholarship Success:

- **Start Early!** The process opens January 20 and applications are due Tuesday, April 18. Many scholarships require recommendations, personal essays, and unofficial transcripts to complete your applications. Don't wait until the last minute to start your application!
- **Complete Your Profile!** The more complete your profile, the better informed the scholarship committee will be when making final decisions.
- **Wow Them with Your Personal Statement!** Personal statements and essays are the best way to tell the scholarship committee why you deserve this scholarship. Be sure to provide well-written, creative statements that define your aspirations, career goals, and talents.
- **Follow Directions!** Be sure to read the application requirements closely and follow the instructions word for word. At the same time, keep it simple. Don't waste time submitting additional application materials that are not required because they will not be included in the review process.
- **Submit On Time!** You must submit complete applications by the Tuesday, April 18, 2017 deadline or your application will not be considered.
