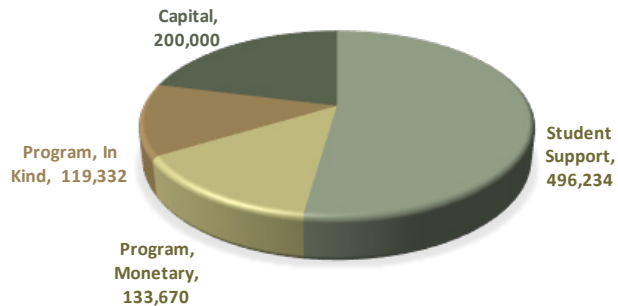

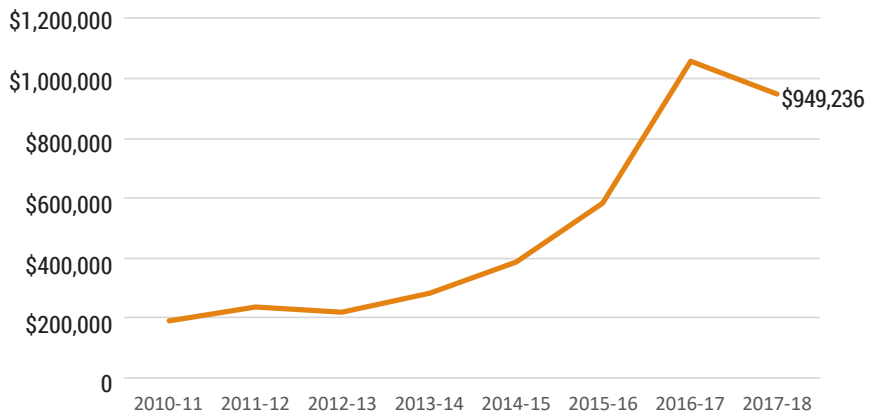


Highlights:

Peninsula College Students

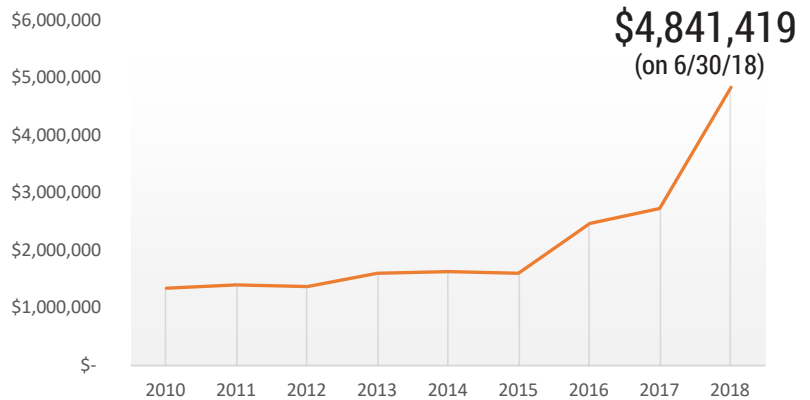
Scholarships, grants, loans, educational conferences, research opportunities, travel, emergency assistance.

Designated (restricted):	\$929,897	\$6,000,000
Endowment:	\$3,299,575	\$5,000,000
Custodial:	\$512,832	\$4,000,000
Unrestricted Reserve:	\$99,115	\$3,000,000
