- Plan to obtain a Healthcare Provider CPR card that will last through at least through June 2019. Nothing to submit with application. If you are admitted to the program, you will be required to submit your card by October 1, 2018.

- Prepare your resume. Clearly document on your resume any healthcare work or volunteer experience you may have, as well as health related trainings, licenses or certifications you may have (EMT, MA, NA-C, Corpsmen, etc). Submit with your application.
