Policy Purpose. Peninsula College administers pedestrian and vehicular traffic on property owned, operated, or maintained by the College in a fair and uniform method based on the following objectives:

- 1. To maintain an easily accessible campus.
- 2. To ensure access for emergency equipment at all times.
- 3. To minimize traffic disturbances.
- 4. To facilitate the operation of the College.
- 5. To protect state property.

Permission to park or operate a vehicle on College property is governed by this policy and its procedures.

Authority. Pursuant to the authority granted by RCW 28B.50.140(10), the board of trustees of Community College District No. 1 empowers the president or designee to make rules and regulations for pedestrian and vehicular traffic on property owned, operated, or maintained by the college district.
