"I" Incomplete Grade & Policy

Student has completed most (80% or more) of coursework, has attended most (80% or more) of the quarter, has extenuating circumstances preventing completion of coursework (death, hospitalization; family emergency), and initiates and signs contract.

Incompletes must be resolved within one year of the end of the quarter in which the student was enrolled in the course. If not completed within one year, the "I" will remain on the transcript, and no credit will be granted.

"&" Common Course

A course with an "&" is common among Washington State Community and Technical Colleges with the same course.

"P" Performing/Fine Art Courses

A minimum of three credits and a maximum of five credits in one area meet distribution credit in Humanities.

Academic Progress and Performance

A student whose cumulative GPA falls below 2.00 will be placed on Academic Alert. A student will be placed on Academic Probation at the end of any subsequent quarter in which their cumulative GPA is below 2.00. A student will be placed on Academic Suspension at the end of any third quarter in which their quarterly GPA is below 2.00. Students must appeal for academic reinstatement.
