This general transfer guide does not include specific dates for specific schools; that information must be obtained from your prospective colleges and universities.

By the end of the First year...

- $\hfill\square$ Select a major or area of study.
- □ Narrow your potential transfer schools to a maximum of 3-5 schools.
- □ Make a list of transfer requirements for your school(s) and major.
- \Box Know which degree you are pursuing at PC.
- □ With your advisor, create an education plan with the courses needed for degree completion.

In The Second Year...

Fall

- Apply for admission to your transfer school(s) of choice, (including providing copies of official transcripts from all schools you have attended).
- Contact an advisor at your prospective transfer school(s).
- Research scholarship eligibility requirements and deadlines, prepare for applying.

- \Box Talk with college representatives that visit PC.
- □ Contact an advisor at the transfer institution you are considering to ensure your, make sure the education plan will work for your major.
- □ Visit the campus (if applicable) of your potential transfer school(s).
- □ Complete interest cards to receive information from schools.

- Complete the FAFSA and additional financial aid material required by your transfer school.
- □ Complete scholarship applications.
- □ Start considering housing options at your transfer school.

Spring

- □ Complete graduation requirements for PC.
- □ Accept/reject university offers.
- $\Box \quad \text{Apply for housing (if needed).}$
- □ Request final transcript from PC after grades and degrees are posted.
- Attend a Transfer
 Orientation/Registration
 session at transfer
 institution.
