Many students struggle to obtain a college degree due to the rising costs of education in this country.

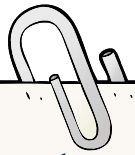
To address this need, the Hearthstone Scholarship Fund was established in 2009.

Since its inception, the scholarship committee has awarded more than \$950,000 in scholarships to students from California, Georgia, New Jersey, Oregon, and Washington. Scholarship awards range from \$500 to \$5,000.

- Personal Statement
- 2 Letters of Recommendation
- Federal Tax Return
- FAFSA or Dream Act Report
- Official Transcript(s)
- Supplemental Materials *(optional)*

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Be from a low-income household or demonstrate financial need
- Be 15–25 years old as of March 31
- Be a resident of a Hearthstone property or a county where a Hearthstone property is located
- Be a full-time student attending a high school, college, university, or vocational school in the U.S.
- Maintain a minimum GPA (3.0 GPA high school or 2.75 GPA college)
- Be available for a phone interview with a committee member in May
