<u>Verification Worksheet – Independent – 2024-2025</u>

Your FAFSA application was randomly selected by the federal processor for a process called "verification." The law states that before awarding Federal Student Aid we may ask you to confirm the information you (and your spouse, if applicable) reported on your FAFSA. The Financial Aid Office will compare information from your FAFSA with your and your spouse's financial documents. Peninsula College may be required to correct your FAFSA if there are differences between your FAFSA and the documents you submit for verification.

Required Steps and Instructions:

- Complete all sections of this worksheet, including signatures, in blue or black ink. (We cannot accept pencil.) You MUST sign this worksheet. Electronic signatures are not permitted.
- Submit this worksheet and other required documents to the Financial Aid Office via regular mail or fax, or via our secure drop box, here. Please do not send information via email; it is not secure. Do not submit this worksheet to the U.S. Dept. of Education.
- Incomplete workshoots will not be accorded. These documents are required to complete your financial aid file and must be submitted

Student Tax and Income Information for 2022:

The FUTURE Act of 2019 requires the Department of Education to access the Federal Tax Information (FTI) of FAFSA applicants—and, where applicable, their parents and spouses—through a secure method. Students and parents must provide their consent on the FAFSA for the exchange of FTI; it is now a requirement for receiving federal student aid, even if the student or parent did not file taxes for that year or did not have income.

If the student and/or parent does not provide consent on the FAFSA for the transfer of their information from the IRS, the student will not be eligible for federal student aid until the necessary consent is provided. If you did not provide consent on the FAFSA and would like to, please login to the FAFSA at www.studentaid.gov to submit a correction to the application.
