Fitness Center Fund Reallocation

What's on the ballot?

Peninsula College students will vote on whether or not to authorize the Associated Student Council to reallocate excess funding collected for the construction of the fitness center.

Who can vote?

All PC students currently enrolled in 1 or more credits.

What time are the polls open?

The voting station, located in the PUB, will open at 9 a.m. and close at 2 p.m. on Oct. 24.

What is the rationale?

The students of Peninsula College voted in April of 2010 to assess themselves a fee for the construction of a fitness center. That fee was collected, the fitness center was built, and the fee continued until the project was paid off in 2022. Additional funds continued to come in during that payoff period, totaling \$219,000. The Associated Student Council, who operates the fitness center, would like to move some or all of that funding from the fitness center account into their reserve account, where it could be used on the fitness center, but also could be used for other student projects. Since the student body voted on the original fee for the purpose of constructing a fitness center, the ASC is conducting a vote for permission to reallocate those funds.

What if I can't be there to vote in person?

You may arrange a proxy vote on or before 2 p.m., Oct. 24, by emailing the ASC with your name, your student ID, and your vote (yes or no). A member of the ASC will cast a ballot in your behalf and cross your name off a separate list to insure students vote only once. All voting will be otherwise anonymous.
