


How to Reset Your ctcLink Password

This guide will show you how to reset your ctcLink password.



Proceed to ctclink:

1. Open web browser and go to gateway.ctclink.us.

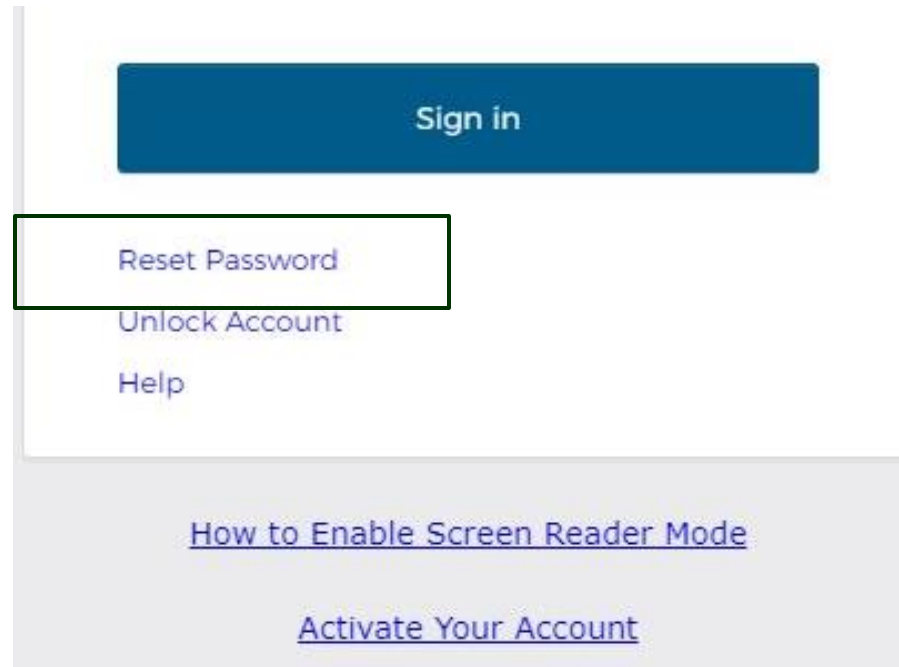

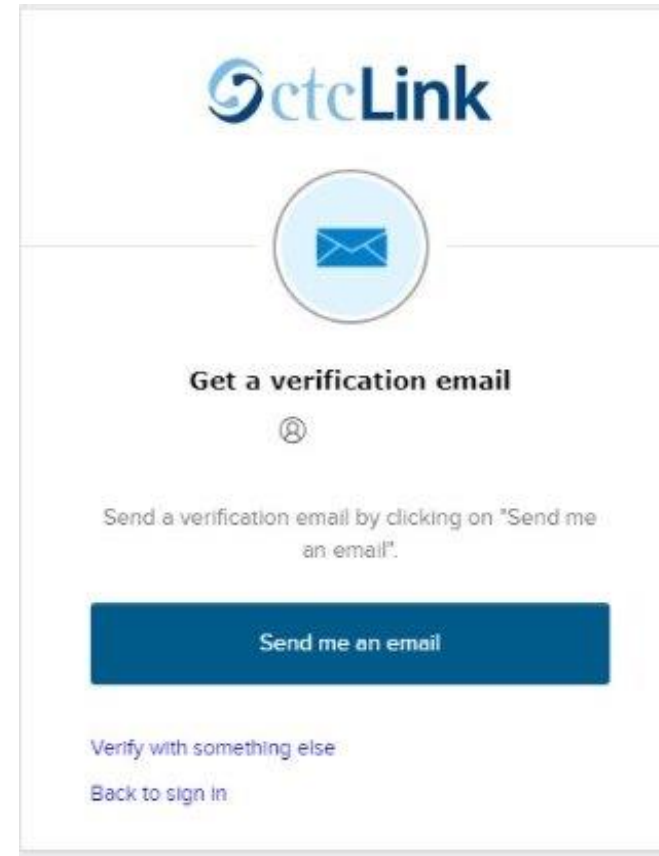
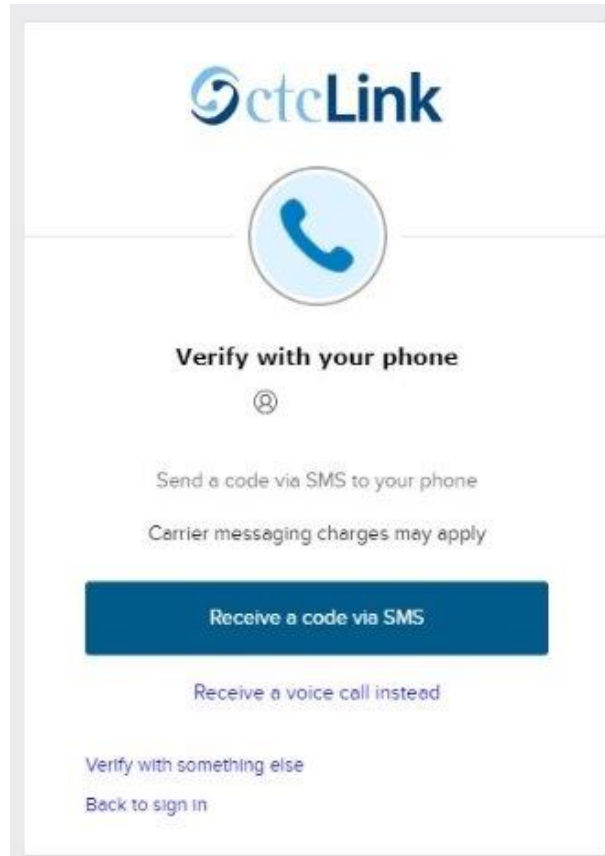
4. Verify your account with email or phone.
