



## STEP 1: COMPLETE PLACEMENT TO QUALIFY FOR RUNNING START

- Placement options assess your English and math skills to determine appropriate course-level placement. Students can qualify for Running Start through placement in English only, math only, or both.

## STEP 5: SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT WITH YOUR PENINSULA COLLEGE ADVISOR

- Once you've completed the first four steps, a Bookings link will be emailed to schedule an appointment with your advisor. Advising appointments are in-person or virtual. You will work with your academic advisor to make an education plan and register for classes. Running Start students must meet with an advisor before registering for classes.

## STEP 6: REGISTER FOR CLASSES, PAY FEES & GET YOUR TEXTBOOKS
