- Recommendation 4: Spring 2018 Mission Fulfillment and Sustainability - Document and evaluate its cycle of planning and assessment of results to ensure their adequacy, alignment, and effectiveness and uses the results to make changes, as necessary, for improvement. (2020 Standard(s) 5.B.2)
